Eligibility requirements:

- Rising Sophomore
- A cumulative GPA of at least 3.0
- Currently enrolled in a NCSU Music Department ensemble
- Open to all vocal and instrumental musicians

Application requirements:

- Completed scholarship application
- Unofficial Transcript (printed from PackTracks)
- One letter of recommendation from a NCSU Music Department faculty member
- Typed musical resume (ensembles, awards, private lessons, other musical qualifications; include dates and instrument/voice part for all listings; may include high school activities)
- 2-3 pages (typed, double-spaced) essay on topic found on application page

Receipt requirements during Fall and Spring semesters of sophomore year at NCSU:

- Full-time enrollment
- Cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Enrollment in at least one (1) NCSU Music Department class or ensemble, or pledge Mu Beta Psi
